

International Cargo Bike Festival 2026

Exhibitor Terms & Conditions

1. Introduction

These Terms & Conditions ("Terms") are established by Fietsdiensten.nl, (Groenestraat 294, 6531 JC Nijmegen, The Netherlands) (the "Organiser") for exhibitors participating in the 2026 edition of the International Cargo Bike Festival ("ICBF 2026"). By submitting an application to exhibit at ICBF 2026, you (the "Exhibitor") agree to be bound by these Terms.

2. Exhibition space

- All Exhibition Space ("Exhibition Space") is measured in m² and is allocated subject to availability.
- The Organiser reserves the right to revise the floor layout plan at any time and to change the allocation of an Exhibitor's Exhibition Space if deemed necessary.
- Although the Organiser will do their best to allocate positions based on preferences passed on in writing by the Exhibitor, the final position of each Exhibition Space within ICBF 2026 is solely at the Organiser's discretion.

3. Exhibitor Eligibility

- The Organiser reserves the right to refuse participation to any Organisation, Company, or individual.
- The Exhibitor may share their Exhibition Space with another company, organisation or individual, but only with the express written consent of the Organiser. In case such express written consent, the Organiser does not guarantee any promotional activities to the other company, organisation or individual via social media, the ICBF website or any other means, except at the Organiser's discretion.
- This Agreement is specific to the Exhibitor. The Exhibitor is not entitled to assign, sublet, sub-license or otherwise transfer in respect of the whole or any part of the Exhibition Space allocated to them without the express written consent of the Organiser.

4. Inclusions

- Fees for Exhibition Space include:
 - Exhibition Space in m²
 - Electrical connection

- Test-track access
 - WiFi access
 - Social media post on ICBF channels
 - Exhibitor profile on ICBF website
 - Presence of Expo-Coordinator, Security and First-Aiders
- Any other items, such as stand construction or promotional services are not included unless otherwise arranged for and stated in correspondence or documents agreed upon by the Organiser and Exhibitor.
- All prices are exclusive of BTW (Dutch VAT) and according to the price level of the date of publication of this document. Prices are subject to change.

4. Payment

- Payment for Exhibition Space and any additional services is due **14 days** from the date of the invoice. During this period, the Organiser will reserve the agreed upon Exhibition Space for the Exhibitor.
- Exhibitor applications to participate at ICBF 2026 will not be confirmed until full payment is received.

5. Cancellation and Refunds

- Cancellations made more than three calendar months before ICBF 2026 (**before 12th July 2026**), will receive a full refund, minus a €100 administrative fee.
- Cancellations made **between three calendar months and 45 days** of ICBF 2026 (**between 12th July 2026 and 28th August 2026**), will receive a 50% refund, minus a €100 administrative fee.
- Cancellations made within **45 days** of ICBF 2026 (**from 29th August 2026 onwards**) will not be refunded.

6. Exhibitor Responsibilities

- Exhibitors are responsible for:
 - Set-up, staffing, and breakdown on their Exhibition Space within designated opening times as stated on the ICBF Website.
 - Compliance with all applicable laws and regulations.
 - Obtaining any necessary permits or licences.
 - Security of their own equipment and materials.
- Electricity and internet usage requires adherence to Jaarbeurs (the venue)'s guidelines.

7. Test Track

- Exhibitors are granted free use of the ICBF 2026 test track to demonstrate their products and/or services to potential customers.
- Exhibitors must adhere to all posted safety rules and regulations when using the test track.
- The Organiser reserves the right to restrict access to the test track due to weather conditions, overcrowding, or other unforeseen circumstances.
- The Organiser will take all reasonable steps to create a safe test track, but will not be liable for any damage, personal injury, loss or theft taking place as a result of Exhibitors use of the test track.

8. Force Majeure

- The Organiser shall not be liable for any delay or failure to perform its obligations under these Terms & Conditions if such delay or failure is caused by an event of Force Majeure. For the purposes of this Clause, "Force Majeure" means any act or event beyond the reasonable control of a Party, including (without limitation) acts of God, natural disasters, strikes, terrorism, war, governmental action, or a national emergency.

9. Liability

- The Organiser will not be liable for any loss, theft, or damage to Exhibitor property, or personal injury occurring during ICBF 2026.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to obtain their own insurance to cover such eventualities.

10. Media and Publicity

- The Organiser reserves the right to use photos or videos of ICBF 2026 for any purpose.

11. Acceptance

These Terms & Conditions constitute the entire agreement between the Organiser and the Exhibitor. They supersede any prior or contemporaneous communications, representations, or agreements.

12. Governing Law

These Terms & Conditions will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the Netherlands.
